



NEW COMMUNITY WARDEN SERVICE FOR THE NEIGHBOURHOOD

St David's Community Warden Scheme, set up with funding from Devon County Councillor Jill Owen and The People's Health Trust, starts on Tuesday 1 November 2016.

The Warden service is available to residents and businesses living/working in St David's Neighbourhood and, by agreement, to adjacent areas such as Bury Meadow Park and Bartholomew's Cemetery surrounding streets.

The Neighbourhood will be patrolled by Community Warden (Brandon) who is equipped with a high quality body-camera with audio to record incidents and problems.

Reporting problems with anti-social behaviour will help our Warden build a map of issues around the Neighbourhood which will also help target problem areas and provide information for our Police service.

The Community Warden service is NOT a replacement for our law enforcement officers. Continue to contact the Police in the usual way.

The Community Warden will introduce himself to you and feel free to discuss any anti-social issues which are causing you concern.

'Patronus', based in St David's, is providing the Community Warden service. Patronus already provides services to Exeter City Council and works closely with the University Estate Patrol and this extension to St David's Neighbourhood and fringe areas will support other agencies who provide services. *There is more information on the website:*
